The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2004 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act is deemed to have come into force on the commencement of section 14 of the principal Act.

3 Conditions of off-licences

Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following subsections:

- “(4) This section applies—
- “(a) not only to licences issued on or after the commencement of this section; but
 - “(b) also to licences in force immediately before the commencement of this section.
- “(5) Subsection (4) applies to avoid doubt.”
